WORKPLACE GIVING

Enables you as an employee to make a real difference through regular donations from your pre-tax pay whilst going about your everyday work. It doesn't take much - in fact you probably won't notice the difference to your pay - but with your ongoing support through payroll giving, we can plan better and do more!

By donating money directly through your payroll system, you can obtain the tax benefit immediately, rather than applying at the end of financial year. Your nominated donation amount is deducted from your salary on each pay day, before deducting your tax so the benefit to you is immediate.

- You can donate as much or as little as you like (minimum \$1.00).
- There is no need for you to remember to make a payment each month.
- You can opt out anytime - you have full control over your giving.
- It's a tax effective way to give to a charity - costing you less to give more.

Why payroll give?

Workplace Giving is one of the single most powerful acts you can do to help us support the future of young people on the margins.

It means that we can rely on regular financial support, enabling us to plan into the future, budget more effectively and ultimately change to world for these young people and help them reach their brightest potential by investing in their education and skills.

Start making a difference now

Workplace Giving is really easy. Simply choose how much you wish to donate to Australian Marist Solidarity each pay, and contact your payroll to set up a regular donation. From there, payroll can assist you with any enquiries regarding your Workplace Giving arrangements.

How to make a payroll donation:

There are four easy steps in organising your payroll donation:

- Check with your employer and confirm they support Payroll Giving.
- Download the Payroll Giving Form and give the completed form to your payroll manager.
- Instruct your payroll manager to deduct your nominated donation amount from your pre-tax salary each pay period.
- Request the payroll manager to forward the authorisation form to us.

Australian Marist Solidarity supports the St Marcellin School which provides free education and boarding to tea garden children that enables them to break the cycle of poverty and rise above the bonded life that they were born into.

Women working in the tea fields must work quickly and delicately to pick the top tea leaves from the bushes. The work is strenuous and poorly paid. St Marcellin School seeks to break this cycle of indentured labour and provides access to education for some of the most marginalised children.
